**ORDER FINDING GOOD CAUSE TO ADOPT A LOCAL COURT RULE AT
TIME OTHER THAN ESTABLISHED SCHEDULE**

The Judges of the Jasper Circuit Court and the Jasper Superior Court, pursuant to Trial Rule 81, now find good cause exists to deviate from the schedule established by the Division of State Court Administration for publishing local rules to facilitate changes necessary for the sound administration of justice. The Jasper County Local Rule 37-AR00-15 requires revision to comply with Ind. Code § 12-23-14-16 and allow the Jasper County Drug and Alcohol Program to be recertified by the Indiana Office of Court Services.


After posting for comment for 30 days and after approval by the Division of State Court Administration and the Indiana Supreme Court, the rules will become effective and the Clerk shall post the Rules in the Clerk's Office and on the website of the Clerk and the Jasper Circuit and Superior Courts. The Clerk shall also mail, a copy of the new rules to each member of the Jasper County Bar, and have copies available in each Clerk's office for any interested person.

The Courts also jointly revoke any prior local rule for either Circuit or Superior Court.

Notice of Proposed New Local Rules

The Judges of the Jasper Circuit and Superior Courts, pursuant to Trial Rule 81(B), give notice of a revision to prior Local Rule LR37-AR-00-15, and find good cause to deviate from the schedule for adopting local rules under Trial Rule 81(D). This proposed revision to the rule will be effective upon the expiration of the comment period listed below. The proposed rule revision is to comply with Ind. Code §12-23-14-16, a necessary step to continuing certification of the Jasper County Courts Drug and Alcohol Program by the Indiana Office of Court Services. The proposed rule is listed below.

LR37-AR00-15 Alcohol and Drug Program Fees

A. All persons directed to participate in the Jasper Circuit or Jasper Superior Court certified alcohol and drug court program shall pay a program fee of \$400.00 or the highest allowable charge pursuant to Indiana Law for court certified alcohol and drug programs under Ind. Code § 12-23-14-16.

B. All persons directed to participate in the Jasper Circuit or Jasper Superior Court certified alcohol and drug court program, but who elect to complete counseling through another court certified program in their home county, shall pay a tracking fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

~~C. For distance learning courses provided by the Probation Department or a contracted service provider the Court may charge a tracking service fee as negotiated and contracted with the Court to provide services.~~

~~D. Notwithstanding any provision of this Rule, the Court may charge a different fee, higher or lower, necessitated by change in the contracted costs between the Courts and any service provider who provides any service for which a fee is assessed under this Rule.~~

In accordance with Trial Rule 81(B), the time period for the bar and the public to **comment** will close on **October 15, 2021**.
